Dalmatian

Puppy 3 (0)

- 1st Neath-Duggan's Buffrey Gift Wrapped. At 7mths this delightful B/W is already on the road to success, deservedly so! An attractive head, dark eye and a pleasing expression. Developing a good reach of neck leading to a sound front assembly with strong rounded bone and tightening feet. She has a balanced outline, body supported with strong hindquarters. One of the best movers of the day. **Best Puppy, RBOB & Utility Puppy Group 3**
- 2nd Webster's Tynevale Truly Talented At Dalmarno. The liver pigment, head and body construction is typical of his breeder, masculine and long in loin. Excellent length of stride. A young boy with time on his side for maturity.
- 3rd Neath-Duggan's Buffrey Follow that Star.

Junior 5(1ab)

- 1st Williams Phadante One Vision. A feminine L/W B. No over exaggeration in any area. Soundly made, good forward and rear angulations, topline, croup and tailset , balanced on the move, well handled.
- 2nd Whiting's Cibrith China Aster. Another quality filled feminine L/W B. Attractively spotty, stylish, super profile, sound movement. Slightly smaller and less mature than 1st
- 3rd Evans Caprilli's Hi-De-Ho.

Graduate 2(0)

- 1st As 2nd above.
- 2nd Williams Phadante Take A Chance On Me. A lightly B/W pigmented bitch. Good shaped skull, well set on ears. Well bodied, good topline. Moved soundly.

Postgraduate 4(2ab)

- 1st Willis Cibrith Cosworth. An honest L/W, coby type. A balanced, strong boy. Good head and neck into defined clean withers. Has a deep chest and front assembly onto dense round bone down to tight toes, elbows well placed. Super spring of pastern and tight feet. Well developed second thigh, hocks and stifle. This dog is just as good in profile as he is moving. Covering the ground effortlessly and rhythmically. **Best of Breed & Utility Group 3**

Open 2(0)

- 1st Neath-Duggan's Tumbril Trueblue Buffrey. A veteran boy who belies his age! Retaining balance and topline on the move, musculature remains defined, free from coarseness.
- 2nd Wallis Aikbank Morgon Spiced At Norfield. An attractive B/W pigmented boy. His movement let him down, converging too closely for my liking.
