Junior: (2-1)

1. Forshaw's Jarsdam Game on. What a day for this lovely red and white baby of just 6 months – BOB and BP at his first show! Lovely dark mask and eyes, ears well placed and used. Good well sprung body, solid bone and plenty of substance for age moved well but not needs to tighten up behind.

GERMAN SPITZ (Klein)

Junior: (4-3)

1. Roberts' Oberitz Sunspot. Eye catching orange sable dog with well balanced head, neat ears, dark eye and pleasing expression. Well constructed, moved freely. Overall a nicely balanced outline finished with a well plumed high set tail.

Postgraduate: (5-2)

1. Penwarne's Sheldamar Spell on Voo. This delightful little black bitch really had it all – except a full coat! – such a pity as this would just have been the icing on the cake. A really pretty head with sweet expression and neat ears. A short coupled deep body, with high set tail, good bone and feet. Moved and showed to perfection, well deserved BOB.

Open: (3-1)

1. Morgan's Love in the Mist. Carrying a full coat of golden sable colour, covering a nicely made body with good lay of shoulder, short back and high set tail. Moved briskly using her nice short hocks and showed well.

GERMAN SPITZ (Mittel)

Junior: (5-1)

1. Hill's Sobriety Hot Chocolate. Most eye catching youngster of 15 months. Dark red sable coat of good texture.
Well balanced head with dark eye, well placed and used ears. Well sprung body, nicely laid shoulder giving good reach of neck. Overall of good size with plenty of substance and good bone. Moved cleanly with a brisk gait. RBOB.

Postgraduate: (2)

1. Mulholland's Zaphon Nebula Rubestar. Presenting a compact outline with attractive head, correct mouth, dark

eye and well set ears, though at times a little reluctant to use them. Nicely made throughout with plenty of substance finishing the picture with a coat of gleaming black of correct texture. Moved and showed well.

2. Hill's Wyndlee Sad Café of Sobriety

Open: (5-1)

1. Mulholland's Sephon Spookz the Tempest. A really outstanding cream dog beautifully made throughout with super reach of neck, deep, well sprung short coupled body with high set tail. Lovely head with well balanced skull, dark eye, correct mouth correctly placed ears. Good legs, tight feet and moved like a dream. Really deserved BOB and later grp 1.

1. Bayliss & Hardy Kertella's Motivation. White male presented in super condition. Lovely balanced head with dark eye, well chiselled foreface and good length of ear leathers. Well laid shoulder giving excellent reach of neck, deep, well sprung and short coupled body. Good bone and substance nice turn of stifle moved and showed extremely well. BOB

POODLES Minature

1. Cutler's Minamia Desired Destiny. What a little cracker! Most attractive head with dark eye, good balance of skull and correct mouth. Good shoulder giving excellent reach of neck, good body for age with deep chest and super coat of harsh textured black. Moved soundly with drive and never stopped showing for a moment. BP and BOB and later P grp 1.
