Headed a quality class, very Stylish 11mth, bl B, excels in profile, loved her feminine head, parallel head planes, dark eye, kind expression, body proportions are correct, with deep brisket, good spring of rib and a level topline, well set tail. Well angulated clean shoulders, but I'd prefer a little less rear angulation. Tip top condition and presentation. Pleased to award BP and later see her PG1.

13mth Bl b, Pleasing type alround, confident, another lovely head with parallel planes and a dark eye. Correct scissor bite, Good forechest, tight feet, enough bone, strong level topline which she held on the move. Strong well let down hocks, muscular second thighs, Impressive side gait and positive driving, sound movement both coming and going.

Quality puppy B, compact balanced outline, wedge head with definite stop, almond dark eye, correct pointed velvet ears, scissor bite, well laid shoulders, well sprung ribs, parallel hocks, rounded padded feet. Moved briskly and straight with purpose. BP & PG3

3. Lewis's Leazehond Brightstar Nighi

Post grad (5)

1. Lewis's Leazehond Brightstar Nighi. Placed third in previous class, but scored here on her soundness and stylish lines. She is an attractive B of good breed type but needs to move with a little more purpose for full advantage. Same comment applies to 2 & 3, its very difficult to assess movement if the handler allows their charge to stop, start and sniff at the ground.

Elegant, graceful B, excellent breed type, long head with oval eye, scissor bite, deep chest with elbows placed directly under withers. Plenty of heart room, arched topline with strong rear end. Ground covering easy movement with positive sound strides.
