LABRADORS

PUPPY (8; 1 abs)

1. Braddon's Trendlewood Perfect Ten: A 7 month yellow bitch, thoroughly enjoying her day out. She was very well balanced, standing 4- square. Coat in excellent condition with good undercoat. A lovely head and excellent pigmentation which gave her a typical expression. Neck was set into well- placed shoulders. Has a well-developed 2nd thigh and good angulation front and back. Moved as one with her handler. BP

3. Britton's Bowstones Bring Me Sunshine

JUNIOR (5; 1 abs)

1. Coode's Warringah's Merriwagga: An 8 month old black bitch with a well shaped head and a good outline overall. Strong neck set into well-placed shoulders. Hindquarters were well developed and well turned stifle. Feet were compact. She moved freely and kept her level topline throughout.

GRADUATE (3; 2 abs)

1. Moody's Trendlewood Finn The Eskimo: A strong black dog with a typical Labrador head. A nice eye colour, which gives him a nice expression. He has well sprung barrel ribs and a chest of good depth and width. He moved well covering the ground adequately and keeping his level topline throughout.

POST GRADUATE (1)

1. Mills's Trendlewood Sing: A feminine yellow bitch in good coat. A good neck into well-placed shoulders and a level topline which she held whilst on the move. Good straight front with nice tight feet. Moved OK but needed to show a little more enthusiasm when on the move.

LIMIT (0)

OPEN DOG (2; 1 abs)

1. Braddon's Trendlewood Only to Fly JW: One to watch. A quality black dog with typical head and kind expression. Front was straight and well-boned. Well sprung barrel ribs with good depth and width of chest. Good reach of neck with level topline, leading to a well set otter tail. He moved well around the ring covering the ground with his long, free stride. BOB

OPEN BITCH (6; 3abs)

1. Hammond's Warringah's Bronte: A nice bitch in good condition. Has a straight front, well-boned, and strong neck into well placed shoulders. Good angulation in the hindquarters which was made more obvious whilst she was on the move. She moved freely and looked as if she could do a day's work!RBOB
