Puppy Dog/Bitch (4)

1st Lockett-Walters, Ralines Here Comes The Sun – Quality red, has so much hair on his quarters appears long cast, not so; he has a compact well made rounded body with plenty of width throughout; deep ribs, prominent forechest with good follow through, strong bone and padded feet; good male head and dark eyes, one to watch out for when fully mature. Best Puppy and Best Opposite Sex

2nd Roberts, Dandydayo Queen Of The Nite – very nice black and tan, held her outline on the move which was free and easy, firm topline, good feet and flat coat.

3rd McCarthy, Nagshall Wings of Love

Junior Dog/Bitch (2)

1st McCarthy, Nagshall Solidasarock – cream with nice head, eye and pigment, unsure of himself today and I felt he could carry more weight; nice feet and coat

Postgrad Dog/Bitch (5)

1st James, Jamesfair Keepitasecret – lovely headed black and tan, super coat and condition, good length of rib and prominent forechest, movement strong and true.

2nd Worswick, Dolyharp Gypsy Music – shaded cream, smaller than above and not so confident, pretty head, dark eye and pigment, muscled rear, nice feet.

3rd McCarthy Nagshall Oklahoma Sunrise JW

Open Dog (2)

1st Richardson, Sirrondach Ebony Damon Hill – black and tan, lots to like in ribbing, topline and front, coat not in bloom but has lots of it, also felt more weight would complete the picture, nice movement in profile, touch close in front.

2nd McCarthy Nagshall All Guns Blazing – longer framed type black and cream and slightly taller than above, nice head and eye, steady mover on good feet.

Open Bitch (2)

1st Lockett-Walters, Ch Ralines Aubra Jean – black and cream, instantly appeals for type, size and balance, beautifully proportioned throughout, has width, depth and femininity, all covered with a long flat silky coat, strode out with confidence. Best Of Breed.

2nd McCarthy, Nagshall Puppet On A String JW – shaded cream, compact and well ribbed, pleasing head, eye and pigment, nice feet

Puppy Dog/Bitch (8)

1st Shuker, Hudgemoor Much Ado At Yewlitt – black and tan right out of the top drawer, spot on for breed type and balance, good width all through, really long ribbing, firm topline, angulated rear with short strong hocks; developed front with good follow through, has length to her head and strong underjaw, one with a future on maturity. Best Puppy and Best Opposite Sex.

2nd mead, Minimead Maid Sweetly – another special puppy in a smaller mould than above, long ribbing, depth of keel, firm quarters and pretty head, has a showy attitude and moves well, not quite a positive in front as above.

3rd Reed, Deercroft Dori

Junior Dog/Bitch (9)

1st Reed, Cedax Octavia Surprise For Deercroft – black and tan of 9 months, instantly appeals for type and balance, length of head and strong jaw, she has an elegant outline and lengthy ribbing, moved true both ways.

2nd Muggleton, Mosiarto Miss Fortune – longer and lower than above, liked her angulated quarters and bunchy feet, confident showgirl.

3rd Williams, Cwmdarhian Cant Touch This

Postgrad Dog/Bitch (8)

1st Worton, Cwmdarhian Little Monty – shaded red surprising little dog, need to get hands on to appreciate what he has to offer, really strong and well made throughout, forechest, underline and length of ribbing all good, holds it all together on the move with strong free strides. Best Of Breed.

2nd Reed, Celtic Oath For Deercroft – balanced shaded red, nice angles front and rear, ribs well back firm topline, moves well.

3rd Williams, Cwmdarhian What A carry On

Open Dog (5)

1st Hunt, Carpaccio Captain Scarlet – 13 months lengthy shaded red masculine male, good head proportions, prominent forechest, gave his handler a hard time but handled to show the best of his qualities, good movement in profile, could carry more weight to his advantage.

2nd Williams, Cwmdarhian Benjamin Button – black and tan, shorter and taller than above, good feet and topline, steady mower.

3rd Muggleton – Mosiarto Mister Big

Open Bitch (8)

1st Williams, Cwmdarhian Molly Malone – shaded red, good shoulder and rear angles, glorious head which is a long clear wedge enhanced by well placed and shaped eyes, keen expression, prominent forechest, strong topline and bunchy feet.

2nd Punter, Jentiki Kendle Welcumen – another shaded red, nice overall balance, well placed shoulder and prominent forechest, deep ribbing carried well back.

3rd Worswick, Kireton Alma Of Dolyharp

2nd Adams, Angelholm Aida – very smart and free moving, good length of ribbing, prominent forechest, feminine head, dark eye, loved her wicked expression.

Junior Dog/Bitch (4)

- 1st Kugow & Holt, Waldmeister Johnson – bouncy happy boy, loved his head and eye, keen expression, level topline and really harse coat, muscular quarters, moved true both ways. Best Of Breed.
2nd Price, Samlane Zaffiro – compact and well ribbed, pretty head and nice shaped eye, moved well.

Postgrad Dog/Bitch (7)

2nd Hooper, Starhill Comedy Of Errors – nice body shape with firm topline, feminine head with appealing expression, good texture to coat, nice feet.

Open Dog (2)

- 1st Punter, Welcumen Jeremy – nice type, good front and ribbing, strong quarters.
2nd Kugow & Holt, Waldmeister Samuel JW – taller than above and shorter in ribbing, really liked his head, eye and strength of jaw, very fit.

Open Bitch (8)

- 1st Price, Samlane Touch Of Gin – good overall balance, well constructed with long ribbing and prominent forechest, good bone and feet, strong rear, has width throughout, free mover. Best Opposite Sex
2nd Betteridge, Brindeckel I Luv Lucy Ay Sylvax – longer type than above, head and eye lovely, arched neck into firm topline, harse coat, steady mover.
