AFGHANS – 3 good youngsters. **J** (3) 1 BOB Buttie's Sarakhan Shamir, impressive masculine boy, stronger head type, plenty of neck, scored on upper arm, firm topline, correct croup, more together on the move at this stage with characteristic spring, shapely body, sufficient angulation to give scope for the future; 2 RBOB Hartigan, Traversari & Greenwood's Altside Louis Vuitton; 3 Traversari, Greenwood & Vickers' Altside Glitter And Twisted. **PG** (3,1a) 1, 2 Repeat. **O** (1) A. **L/C CHIHUAHUAS** – **PG, O** (4,2) 1 BOB Baranzeck's Happyhouse Solo at Capevidle, taller boy, scored on head & mouth, reachy neck, correct eyes & ears, could be truer in front & have more hind angulation but strode out smartly; 2 RBOB Baranzeck's Coltham Painted Rascal at Capevidle. **S/C**

CHIHUAHUAS – Quality entry all through. **J** (1) 1 BP, RBOB Folkes & Cowles' Kautostar Catch Me If You Can, attractive cream puppy, good head type, super eyes & expression, ears at correct angle, true front, correct feet, moved out with style, mustn't carry any more weight. **PG** (2) 1 Greening's Stepheter Rufus of Hamaja, small smart quality b/t, typical head, good ears, level back, well carried tail, scored on front, well balanced, true mover, could just have a shade more scope; 2 Folkes & Cowles' Copymear Hugo Boss. **O** (3) 1 BOB Baker's Ch/Am Ch Rafina Logan's Run at Silverbriar, small stylish r/w parti with great personality, really makes his presence felt, loved his head, eyes, muzzle & stop, correct shoulders, well muscled & angulated hindquarters, level topline, well carried tail, every inch the showman, a little star; 2 Greening's Stepheter Willy Nilly of Hamaja; 3 Folkes & Cowles' Veejim My My Delilah. **KING CHARLES** – **J** (5,4) 1 BP Stone's Maynorth Lovesong, quality tri baby, needs to settle but has much promise, pretty feminine head, good eye & expression, enough neck, true front, looks going round, just needs to develop in hindquarters. **PG** (3) 1 Wallhead's Sleepyhollow Trikki Dikki at Merida, super headed boy with some presence, good skull shape, lustrous dark eyes, in good coat, looks the part going round but rather narrow coming & going; 2 Stone's Maynorth Fallen From Heaven. **O** (5,3) 1 BOB Stone's Maynorth Irresistible, attractive four square girl, quality head type, coat could lie a shade straighter but scored heavily on cobbiness & strength of hindquarters; 2 RBOB Wallhead's Palteemoor Charlemange. **MIN PINS** – 3 quality types, pup was the one on form. **J** (1) 1 BOB Coull's Vardenais Moon Chime, classy 10 months red, scored on head proportions, clean shoulders, typical action going round, full of style, well bodied already, good hind angulation, just needs to settle in hind action but most promising. **O** (2) 1 RBOB Coull's Vardenais Just A Thought, typy b/t, eventually settled enough to score over kennelmate who was a shade matronly today, true front, short back, neat hindquarters, four square, pup had that shade more elegance; 2 Coull's Ch Impala

Chase The Sun to Vardenais. **PUGS – J** (1) 1 BP Baker's Silverbriar Rioja, handsome masculine pup with presence, correct topline, well set tail, powerful hindquarters used well on the move, correct eyes, good showman, a shade upright in front & needs to settle in front action. **PG** (5,2) 1 BOB Hunt's Mylforbe Captain Pugwash at Carpaccio, scored on size & balance, good substance & carrying a sensible amount of weight, short & compact, strong hindquarters, good tail set, level topline, quality head; 2 Phelps-Terrett & Terrett's Maid Mdnia; 3 Bradley's Pugmeister Beau Geste. **O** (3) 1 RBOB Hunt's Mylforbe Lilli Marleen at Carpaccio, sister to BOB, not quite so settled or going so well behind but scored on her lovely head, eyes & expression, correct neck length, true front, well bodied, the right balance, a touch more compact than 2 Bradley's Witherford Angel Lips; 3 Phelps-Terrett & Terrett's Kenmilleven Emerald Charm. **NSC PASTORAL – P** (2) 1 BP Lewis' Starvon Vanquish, typy Vallhund, masculine head, well balanced, correct topline, powerful hindquarters, plenty of bone, good feet, just needs to settle in front; 2 Bermingham & Kendrick's Estrela Haia da Casa de Loas em Bamcwt. **J** (2) 1 Dean's Asterel Carrapichana, feminine shapely Estrela, good front, stands true, correct tail, more mature & at this stage firmer behind than her promising brother 2 Dean's Asterel Belmonte. **PG** (2) 1 Lewis' Starvon Spirit Of Christmas, extrovert Vallhund, strong male head, enough neck, well bodied, OK tail & hindquarters, front could be truer; 2 Reid's Estrela Asterel Chquitita at Milagre. **O** (5) Interesting class. 1 BNSC Vines' Ch Ailort Highlander at Parvodene, super quality Buhund, compact & four square, super head type, the right neck & topline, enough bend of stifle, looked excellent going round; 2 RBNSC Bermingham & Kendrick's Estrela Asterel Mamma Mia of Bamcwt; 3 Dean's Estrela Xuva da Costa Oeste at Asterel. **PASTORAL GROUP – G1** Allmark Fifth Avenue, superb Aus Shepherd, just 8 months with exceptional promise, beautifully made, true both ways, remarkably well co-ordinated going round, well boned but still feminine, something special; 2 Shanlimore Pandora, Pyrenean junior, super balance, it all fits together neatly, just the right angles without exaggeration, feminine expression, full of quality; 3 Ch Tamlin King George The First, lovely Cardigan in his prime, classic outline, plenty of substance, flowing lines all through; 4 Buhund. **PG1**, BPIS Aus Shepherd; 2 Tonkory Zeze Peezey, impressive masculine Border Collie, quite the showman, super bone, front, topline & hindquarters, another to watch; 3 Pipadene Ultimate Dream, gorgeous Beardie, compared with 1 & 2 a real baby but already has a beautiful make & shape with the clean outline that comes from the right angles, if she ended up a star I wouldn't be at all surprised; 4 Blueagean Aphrodite by Kalinski, eye-catching Samoyed with scope to mature into, completed a stylish quartet.
